This year will be no different and I invite you to our daily social events, which will provide the perfect opportunity to reunite with old friends, meet new ones all while enjoying great food and music.

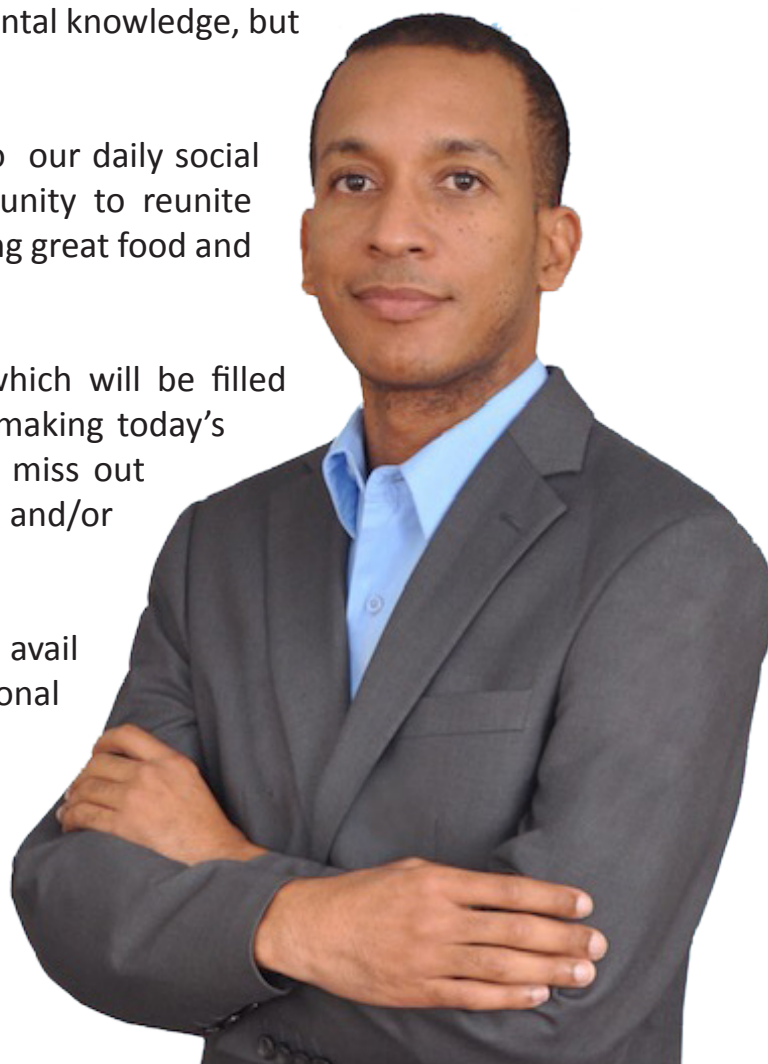

Congratulations to you, Dr. Shaka Cooke and to your dedicated committee members, along with our 2020 convention planner, Ms. Norma Christie.

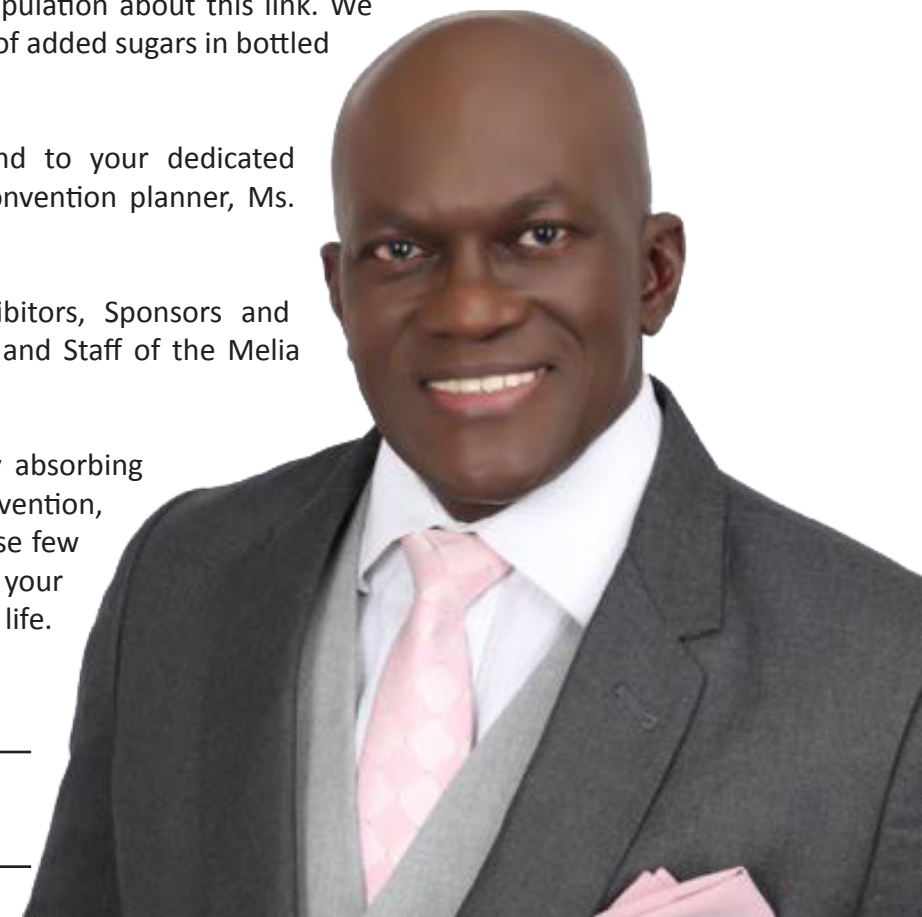
Profound thanks to all our Attendees, Exhibitors, Sponsors and Speakers. Special thanks to the management and Staff of the Melia Braco Village.
